

Legbreaker Challenge July 20th 2008 - Entry Form

The Legbreaker challenge sportive ride will take you through some of the most scenic and secretive Staffordshire Moorlands lanes. The route is tough with little respite but spectacular views. Please ensure you have suitable gearing (34 x 26 is recommended) and fitness to attempt the rides

There are three routes, 164km (102m) with 3784 m of climbing, 130 km (81m) with 3050m of climbing, both passing through Englands' highest village, Flash (1518ft), or 72km (45m) with 1638m of climbing (and no Flash!)

- The entry fee is £22.50 (£20.00 for the 72km route)
- Entrants must be 18 or over
- No entries available on the day
- Maximum field of 500 riders

The HQ for the Legbreaker Challenge Sportive is Leek High School, Springfield Road, Leek, ST13 6EU.

Pre signing on will be at Den Engel Belgian Bar, Stanley Street, Leek, ST13 5HG on Saturday 19th July from 1pm – 5pm.

This will facilitate an early start group.

You will be given your ride number and route card electronic timing chip at registration.

The HQ will be open from 7.15am on Sunday 20th July, with the first group departing at 8am. The route is fully sign posted with marshalling at critical areas.

There are full male & female changing and shower facilities at the HQ. All riders will receive a warm meal when you finish, and there is also further food available at Den Engel if you are not rushing off home.

HQ will be locked from 7pm. If you are not sure you will complete the course within this time please leave your belongings in your car and park in one of the town centre car parks so you will still have access to it. If you reach the second feed station after 4pm and you have not arranged separate parking you will be directed back into Leek, missing out the full route.

There will be three feed stations on the 164km route, 2 on the 130km route and one on the 72km. Feed stations are at 49km (30.5m) and 88km (56m) and 140km (87.5m). All rides follow the same route upto the first feed station, they then split and the 164km and 130km follow the same route back to HQ, you may then continue on the 164km Super Challenge route if you are back to HQ by 14:30, after this time the Super Challenge route will be closed.

If you wish to provide your own food please bring this to the HQ clearly labelled before 8am.

Innertubes and tyres will be available at the feed stations.

Route support is provided by Raynet, a radio communication network. If you are in need of assistance and cannot obtain a mobile phone signal your nearest Raynet car will be able to radio in to base for you.

Terms of entry

You must be 18 years of age on the day of the event to participate.

No refunds are available. Do not allow another rider to participate under your number without informing the organiser and including an updated entry form by June 30th 2008.

Riders number, issued at registration, must be clearly displayed on the back of your jersey. Without your number you will not qualify for any food at the feed station or other support.

You must obey the highway code - ride single file where appropriate and no more than double file at other times. There will be marshals around the route and at feed stations - they have no authority over traffic. Please do not pass through any red lights.

The route is demanding on you and your bike - please ensure your bike is mechanically sound and suitable for the event. Riders are recommended to carry a mini tool, 2 innertubes and a pump / Co2, two drink bottles, energy bar/gel, ID and a small amount of money.

Some of the lanes are very steep and narrow and the use of following vehicles is not encouraged, all vehicles must be prepared to give way at all times and leave sufficient distance for the safe passage of other road users

The route may be altered without prior notice due to weather conditions or road works. The alterations will be clearly marked.

You will consider yourself on a private excursion and rely on your own arrangements in the event of failure to complete the course.

By signing this entry form you agree to participate entirely at your own risk and you understand that no liability shall attach to the organiser, members of leek cyclists' club, proprietors of den engel Belgian bar or any other official of the event, for any injury, loss or damage suffered by you in or by reason of the event however such may be caused and whether by negligence or otherwise.
